M/s EKI Power Trading Private Limited, formerly known as EKI Three Community Projects Private Limited ("Applicant") was granted Category-IV trading Licence (No.107/Trading Licence /2023/CERC) vide order dated 11th December 2023 by the Hon'ble Central Electricity Regulatory Commission ("CERC") as per section 14 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for a period of 25 years from the date of grant of Licence.

 - c. An affidavit to the effect that the Applicant has posted the complete application on its website and shall keep the application uploaded on its website till its disposal by the Commission;
 - d. Document showing that the Licensee has published the notice about its application for revocation in two daily newspapers having circulation in each of the five regions in addition to those published from Delhi, including one economic newspaper"
- 3. The revocation of the license is necessitated by the substantial commercial burdens that have rendered the continued operation of the Applicant financially unviable. The financial strain, coupled with mounting operational costs, has severely impacted the Applicant's profitability. The last trading activity by the Applicant was done in the month of August 2024. Amid heightened competition, market fluctuations, and unpredictability in the power sector, the Applicant was able to enter into only nine commercial contracts from the date of getting a licence, and in that also, the Applicant was not able to do any significant power trading obligation and thereby has to terminate all the signed contracts. Due to the above said reason, the Applicant does not anticipate any future trading activity and thus wishes to have its licence revoked w.e.f. 01.04.2025.
- 5. In consequence to above mentioned fact and circumstances, the Applicant does not wish to continue the trading business and wishes to have it category-IV trading Licence revoked in terms of Regulation 20(3) of the CERC (Procedure, Terms and Conditions for Grant to Trading Licence and other related matters) Regulations, 2020 read with section 19 of the Electricity Act, 2003.
- 6. The Applicant herein intended to move the present Application for revocation under Regulation 20(3) of the CERC (Procedure, Terms and Conditions for Grant to Trading Licence and other related matters), Regulations, 2020 in the month of January 2025 as the last trading activity of the Applicant was done in the August month of 2024. Also, the Applicant has duly paid the annual licence fee for the year 2024-25 till 31.03.2025.
- 7. The Applicant submits that it does not have any undischarged liability against its interstate trading licence nor does it have any live claim raised by any party at present or for the past one year. The Applicant further respectfully submits that there are no operative contracts for trading of electricity to which the Applicant is a party till the date of the filing of the present petition. The Applicant submits that it shall not enter any further contracts in future. 





The Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 14 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (36 of 2003) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), hereby grants this licence as a Category 'IV' trader to EKI Power Trading Private Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013, having its registered office at Plot No. 48, Scheme No. 78, Part-II, Vijay Nagar, Indore-452010, Madhya Pradesh (hereinafter referred to as "the licensee") to trade in electricity as an electricity trader in the whole of India, subject to the terms and conditions contained in the Act, (in particular, Sections 17 to 22 thereof, both inclusive), the Rules made by the Central Government (hereinafter referred to as "the Rules") and the Regulations specified by the Commission from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations"), including statutory amendments, alterations, modifications, re-enactments thereof, which shall be read as part and parcel of this licence.

- 2. This licence is not transferable, except in accordance with the provisions of the Act, the Rules and the Regulations.
- 3. (1) The licensee shall not without prior approval of the Commission-
 - (a) Undertake any transaction to acquire by purchase or take over or otherwise, the utility of any other licensee; or
 - (b) Merge its utility with utility of any other licensee.
 - (2) The licensee shall not at any time assign its licence, or transfer its utility, or any part thereof, by sale, lease, exchange or otherwise without the prior approval of the Commission.
 - (3) Any agreement relating to any transaction referred to in sub-clause (1) and sub-clause (2) unless made with the approval of the Commission, shall be void.

- The grant of this licence to the licensee shall not in any way hinder or restrict the right of the Commission to grant a licence to any other person within the same area for trading in electricity as an electricity trader. The licensee shall not claim any exclusivity.
- 5. The licence shall commence on the date of its issue and unless revoked earlier, shall continue to be in force for a period of 25 (twenty-five) years from the date of its issue.
- The licensee may with prior intimation to the Commission, engage in any business for optimum utilization of its assets:

Provided that the licensee shall not engage in the business of transmission of electricity.

- Unless otherwise specified by the Commission, the licensee shall pay anatum licence fee of ₹3 lakh (Rupees Three Lakh only) and licence fee for a part of the shall be paid on pro rata basis, rounded off to the nearest hundred rupees.
- The provisions contained in Sections 19 to 22, both inclusive, of the Act shall apply to the licensee with regard to revocation of licence and sale of its utility.
- The trading margin in the inter-State trading of electricity, as fixed by the Commission from time to time, shall apply to the licensee.
- The licensee shall comply with the provisions of the Central Electricity Regulatory 10. Commission (Procedure, Terms and Conditions for grant of Trading Licence and other related matters) Regulations, 2020 as amended from time to time and the terms and conditions of the licence as provided in the order dated 15.11.2023 and 11.12.2023 in the Petition No. 304/TD/2023.
